1. With these minutes are also presented minutes of 25 July meeting heretofore withheld until verification and agreement of figures on dormitory allocations.

2. Discussed Declassification and Editorial activities and proposal for eventual organization into a Division with Library and Document Room and Patent Group under R. C. Smith.

3. Discussed requirements of school system for more housing.

4. Discussed request of Lt. Higgins for names of responsible officials to be posted on certain buildings for calling in emergencies. Following questions raised:

a. What is relation of this to emergency pass version recently reviewed?

b. Isn't there always a Security Guard on these special buildings anyway with orders on when to call?

c. Doesn't the SOP at the Fire Department when a call is received from these buildings immediately provide for calling for the responsible technical man?

Col. Seeman felt that the posting of names by Lt. Higgins might be an unnecessary duplication and will contact Maj. Newsburger for further details. A weakness in the existing system was pointed out in that even with names listed there was no certainty that anyone remained on the reservations within reach.

The following additional comments were desired to be confirmed:

a. The emergency passes are confined to four areas:

(1) Tech., (2) Gate 12, (3) DP, (4) Bayo. There is no "All Areas".

b. Does emergency pass permit holder to admit any assistants desired?

c. If Maj. Newsburger is not on list to admit authorized persons to Delta Bldg., he should be, to decrease the possibility that all persons presently authorized to admit should all be absent from the area at one time.

Bayo and Sandia Sites by extension of reservations line eastward. The advantages would be
