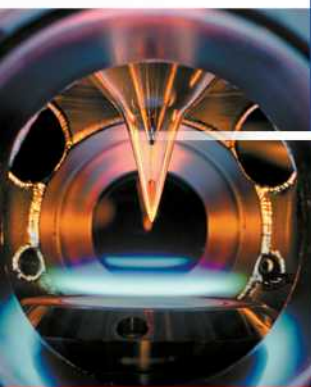

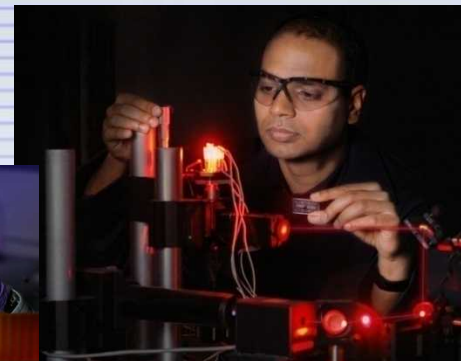

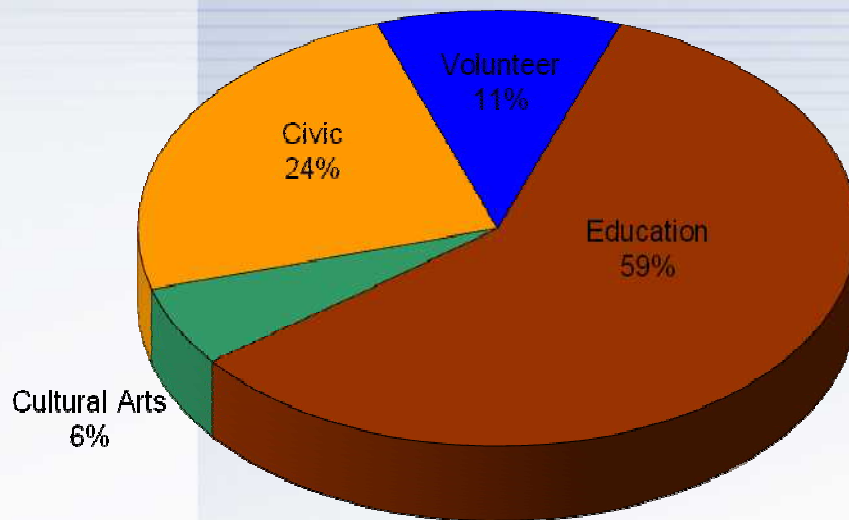
Charitable Giving Program

■ Family Science Night

- Our signature program targets bringing fun and hands-on science exploration to over 3,000 elementary students, teachers, and parents at over 20 local schools.

■ Excellence in Teaching Awards

- Sandia presents three Excellence in Teaching awards to teachers in the Livermore School District.

■ Expanding Your Horizons in Math and Science

- Sponsor a conference for young women in grades 6–9 designed to foster their interest in science and mathematics. Donna Djordjevich, a computer scientist working on gaming in national security applications, will be the keynote speaker this year.

■ Tri-Valley Science and Engineering Fair

- Sandia provides financial support, judges, and other volunteers to the annual competition for students in grades 7-12.

■ DOE Regional and National Science Bowls

- Sandia sponsors two regional Science Bowls for middle school students and one regional Science Bowl for high school students. Last year the two teams that won our regional Science Bowls for middle school students finished first and second in the National Science Bowl.

■ Support to Local Education Foundations

- We provide support to the Livermore Valley Education Foundation and Pleasanton Partners in Education. Our goal this year is to expand that support to other communities in which our employees live.

- Arranged for Tri-Valley Conservancy to serve as an external third-party for the U.S. EPA certification process of Laboratory's environmental organization.



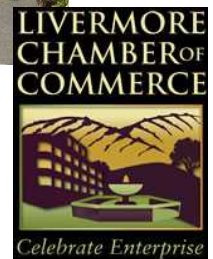
- Sandia is the inaugural recipient of the Livermore Chamber's "Environmental Spirit Award" for green program management and site stewardship.
