Fire Protection SMEs

- **DELIVERABLE:**
 - SME list posted to the EFCOG website
- **ACTION:**
 - Validate Membership
 - Review/Correct Contact Information

Membership

- **Full Membership (\$6,000 annually)**
 - All DOE prime management contractors or their integrated subcontractors
- **Associate Membership (\$3,000 annually)**
 - Any organization that supports a DOE prime contractor as a subcontractor, vendor or consultant, providing they meet the following criteria:
 - The company can provide an employee who will make a beneficial technical contribution to a specific working group; and
 - The company has full approval for membership from its sponsoring DOE prime contractor organization
 - Eligible for all benefits, but not eligible to serve on Board of Directors
- **Small Business Associate (\$1,000 annually)**
 - Any organization that meets the DOE standard requirements for small business designation. Members are eligible for all benefits, but are not eligible to serve on the Board of Directors. Companies must provide documentation of their small business status as part of their application.

- **Pilot reviews of 26 NFPA Codes/Standards in process**
 - Pilot reviews were due April 24th
 - Reps from 13 sites are participating
 - A guidance document and template was developed to establish a standardized approach
