## Next release / code deprecation and removal

---

- **Initial plan:**
  - **11.0 release in June**
- **Who has removed deprecated code since 10.10?**
  - **I don't think some code removal is a show-stopper**
- **Tentative plan from Leaders meeting:**
  - **Release 10.12 in June/July**
  - **Release 11.0 in September**
  - **Allows developers more time to**
    - ◆ **deprecate code now**
    - ◆ **remove code after 10.12**
- **Discussion this afternoon**

- Several documents were identified for exclusion
- New SVN repository created for documents
- Candidate clone will be available after documents are filtered or removed



- Solution identified at U of Indiana
- More general solution being sought
- Would benefit from additional staffing



## Clang & GCC 4.6/4.7 porting

---

- **Clang compilers**
  - Fast
  - New nightly build
  - SIERRA wants to build with Clang
  
- **GCC 4.6**
  - Nightly builds in place
  - SIERRA looking at for default compiler
  
- **GCC 4.7**
  - Required minimum version for ForTrilinos
  - Starting to see mail list inquiries



## SIERRA/Trilinos integration efforts

---

- Integration testing currently stalled
- More testing to be owned by the Trilinos Framework team
- New dedicated machine
- Significant progress on updated integration model



## Subpackage support

---

- Subpackage support added last year
- Any plans to use subpackages this year?
- Impediments (other than time)?





## BSD Licensing

- 30/50 packages licensed BSD in 10.10 (19 in 10.8)
- At least 4 more packages ready to convert

## Copyright delays continue

- Stalls at multiple points in the process
- No significant improvement from last year



## Subset package distribution support added

- Configure with required set of packages
- 'make package\_source'
