Subject: ***Signatories to Documents for Hazardous Waste Management at Sandia National Laboratories/New Mexico, EPA ID NM5890110518***

Sandia Corporation (Sandia) is providing the following information regarding signatories to permit applications and reports submitted under the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act (NMHWA) and Title 20 of the New Mexico Administrative Code, Chapter 4, Part 1, Subpart IX (20.4.1.900 NMAC) incorporating Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 270.11 (40 CFR 270.11).

Sandia is the operator of Sandia National Laboratories (SNL) with respect to management of wastes regulated under the NMHWA and the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (referred to herein as RCRA-regulated wastes). The US Department of Energy, National Nuclear Security Administration (DOE/NNSA) is the owner of SNL.

Permit applications and reports submitted under 20.4.1.900 NMAC/ 40 CFR 270.11 for SNL (referred to herein as RCRA permits and reports) are currently signed and will continue to be signed by persons who meet the requirements in 40 CFR 270.11. These RCRA permits and reports include the following:

- Reports and other correspondence required by current and future RCRA regulations and permits, and other information requested by the NMED Hazardous Waste Bureau.
- Reports and other correspondence regarding the Federal Facilities Compliance Order (FFCO) (October 1995, as amended).

- Reports and other correspondence regarding the Compliance Order on Consent (COOC) (April, 2004) pursuant to the NMHWA.

As required by 40 CFR 270.11, the RCRA permits and reports will be signed for Sandia by the vice president responsible for environmental protection and/or waste management operations at the SNL facility in Albuquerque, New Mexico. This person meets the definition of a responsible corporate officer in 40 CFR 270.11(a)(1). Documents may also be signed by a duly authorized representative who is a center director or deputy director reporting to the vice president responsible for environmental protection and/or waste management operations at the SNL facility in Albuquerque, New Mexico.

At SNL, two vice presidents currently share responsibility for environmental protection and/or waste management. Their respective areas of responsibility are listed below.
