- Drop off artwork at one of the following locations from **September 16th – 19th**
 - Main Library, 501 Copper Avenue NW (Copper & 5th – Downtown) – Friday & Saturday (10am-6pm); Sunday (Closed)**
 - Cherry Hills Library, 6901 Barstow NE (Harper & Academy) – Friday & Saturday (10am-6pm); Sunday (1pm-5pm)**
 - Taylor Ranch Library, 5700 Bogart NW (Montaño & Unser) – Friday & Saturday (10am-6pm); Sunday (1pm-5pm)**
- Note:** Please pick up artwork at the location it was dropped off (**October 14th – 17th, 10am - 6pm**). **All artwork not picked up by October 17th will be discarded.**
- Artwork will be judged on its relationship to this year's theme: "Many Backgrounds, Many Stories...One American Spirit: Muchas Culturas, Muchas Historias... Un Espíritu Americano"

Rules:

- Art must be no larger than 48" X 36" X 1.5"
- Only one entry per student
- Painting, Drawing, and Photography will be accepted
- Must consent to possible reproduction, distribution, and public display of artwork, and release all Hispanic Heritage Month volunteers from any damages that may occur

- Winners will be notified by September 21st 2011 and invited to attend and display their artwork at The Hispanic Heritage Diversity Celebration held at Sandia National Laboratories on Wednesday, September 28th 2011 (11:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.)**
