Overview

- The US Vulnerability Assessment (VA) process can be broken down into three phases:
 - Plan
 - Conduct
 - Report



Plan Phase

- **There are five steps in the planning phase:**
 - **Initiate the VA**
 - **Determine the objective and scope of the VA**
 - **Team selection**
 - **Schedule development**
 - **Information gathering**



Conduct Phase

- **Tasks of the Conduct Phase are to:**
 - Gather data needed to characterize the physical security components
 - Analyze the system's ability to meet specified objectives.



Report Phase

- The Report Phase typically occurs within two steps:
 - Organize results
 - Inform management of results.
