



Environment, Safety & Health at SNL

"The Environment, Safety and Health (ES&H) Policy of Sandia Corporation (Sandia) is to protect and preserve the environment, and to ensure the safety and health of its Members of the Workforce, by providing a place of employment that is, as much as possible, free from recognized hazards that have the potential to cause physical harm to workers." Sandia protects worker health, public health, and the environment through continual improvement, the elimination of hazards and the prevention of pollution.

YOU are responsible for your safety, health and the protection of the environment at Sandia National Laboratories (SNL):

- **Be aware of your surroundings** and all real and potential hazards. Obey all signs and barriers.
- **Consult and involve your Point of Contact (POC) which may be an SNL POC, Host, Escort, or Sandia Contracting/Delegated Representative (SC/DR)** as applicable when planning work, analyzing associated hazards, and identifying appropriate controls for your visit or work activity.
- **Follow procedures** to ensure the protection of your safety and health, and that of other personnel at SNL, the public, and the environment.
- **No eating, drinking, gum chewing, or applying cosmetics** in areas where laboratory chemicals or hazardous materials are present. *SNL Policy prohibits the use of tobacco products on and within all Sandia-controlled premises (e.g., parking lot, building)/property, (e.g., SNL vehicle).*
- **Refrain from participating in any operation and activity-level work that you believe to be unsafe and report operation/condition to your POC or call 311 (on outside line, call 844-0311) for nonemergency hotline.** Do not perform activities involving actual or potential ES&H hazards unless appropriate hazard-specific training has been successfully completed and the activity has been properly authorized. Use Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) as necessary to protect you from hazards. If you observe work an operation/condition that you believe to be unsafe, then you have the authorization and obligation to suspend work.
- **Practice safe behaviors** and use good judgment.
- As applicable, **remain with your Host/Escort at all times.**
