HBE implemented Health Action Plans to address key health risks identified through the 8-15-80 model (preventing or improving eight modifiable risks and behaviors that drive the fifteen chronic conditions which account for 80% of total costs of chronic illness) including inadequate sleep, stress, overweight, physical inactivity, hypertension, dyslipidemia, and poorly managed diabetes. These plans connected employees with onsite health services and emphasized pre and post assessments, building behavioral and emotional skills that promote health and facilitate lifestyle changes over a minimum three month commitment towards taking action.

Overall, 2,934 individuals pledged into 4,436 Health Action Plans (29.16% of the population).
