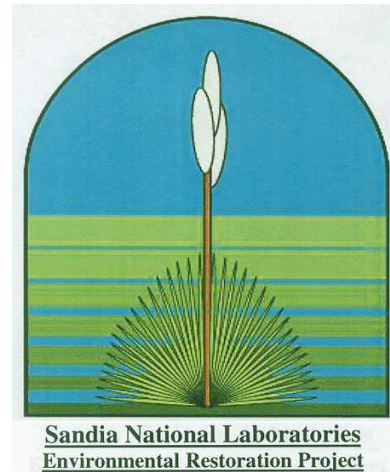


# Sandia National Laboratories' Environmental Restoration Project...
