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Abstract

This bibliography contains approximately 600 references to journal articles, books, book chapters, proceedings, reports, and abstracts published during 1989 under Oak Ridge National Laboratory Biomedical and Environmental Sciences programs. Publications authored by members of the Biology Division, Environmental Sciences Division, and Health and Safety Research Division are listed in addition to those authored by members of divisions that receive funding through the Associate Laboratory Director for Biomedical and Environmental Sciences. Some references from 1988 that were not entered into the Laboratory Records data base in time for the previous publication are also included in this document.

The bibliography is organized by technical category, then by division, and, within each division, alphabetically by the senior author. An index of authors is also provided. Publications listed in this bibliography include 284 journal articles and abstracts, 224 of which appeared in refereed sources; 196 reports; 54 proceedings; and numerous books, book chapters, and miscellaneous publications. Publications not referenced in this document include theses, dissertations, book reviews, most documents or reports prepared for internal distribution, letters to editors, and abstracts published in nonreferenced sources.
