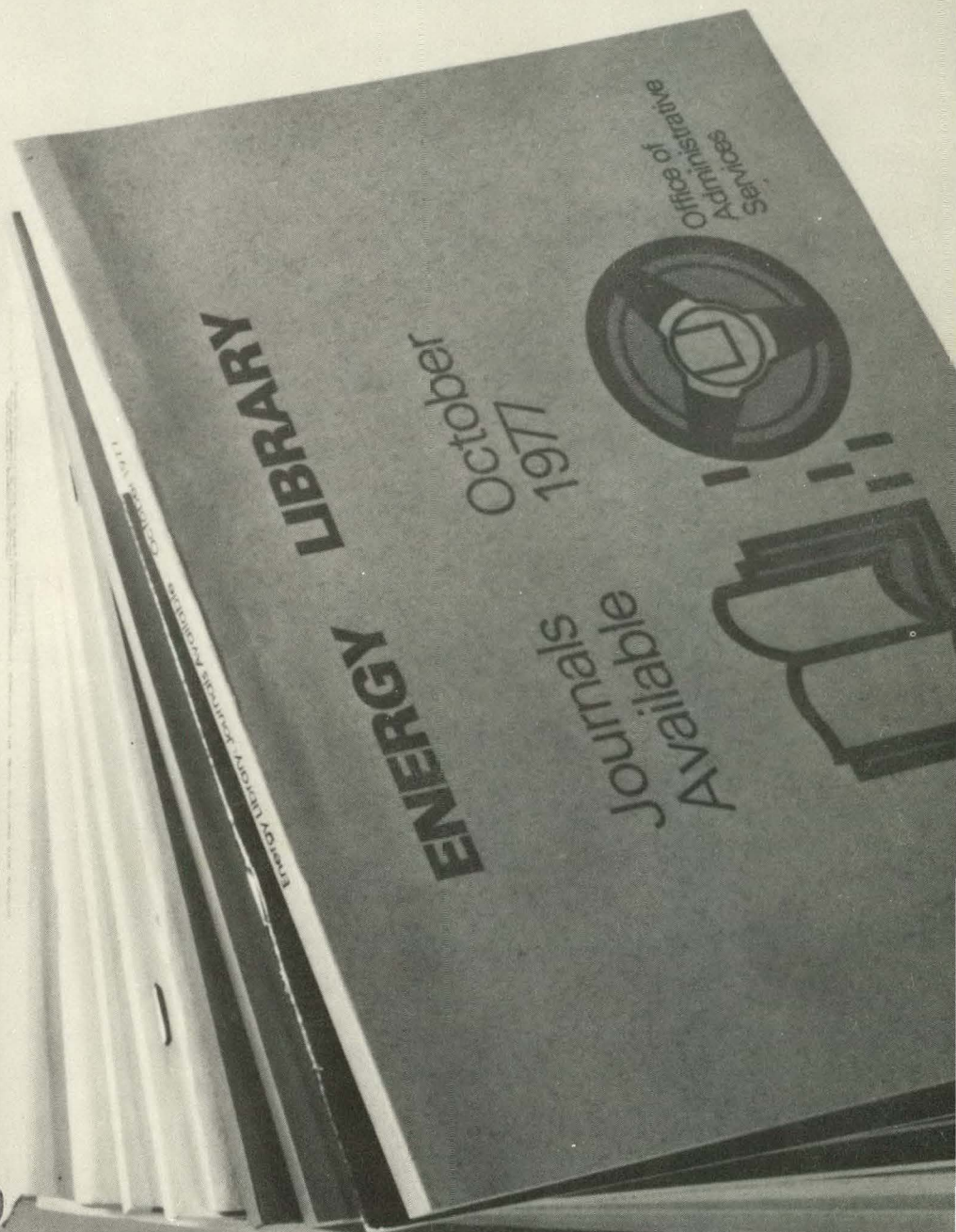
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Preface

This bibliography, *Selected DOE Headquarters Publications Received by the Energy Library*, provides listings of (mainly policy and programmatic) publications issued from the U.S. Department of Energy, Washington, D.C.
